


2. The information sought by the applicant at **Para SI.No.2(iv)** of his application pertains to Coordinaltion Section of the Commission, the reply of which is given below:

The Government of India have informed that the Annual Reports upto 2012-13 have been placed before both the houses of Parliament. The Annual Report for the year 2015-16 is under process. Simultaneously the reports are sent to the State Governments for necessary action as per the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993."
