Reference your Application No. MOEAF/R/2016/80204/1 dated 13/05/2016, seeking information under Right to Information Act 2005.

2. The applicant sought information as below

1. How many gifts did Prime Minister receive during his foreign visits
2. What is the expenditure on gifts given by PM during his foreign visit
3. How much did Government earn by auctioning the gifts received by PM during his foreign visits

3. The following is the response of the CPIO:

1. & 3. No such information is available under the custody of the undersigned.
2. The information sought is non specific and is scattered among different files maintained in the Protocol Division. It would disproportionately divert the scant human resources available at our disposal if we were to compile the required information from so many files and this also attracts provisions of Section 7(9) of the RTI Act, 2005. Nevertheless, in view of the principles of transparency and accountability as enshrined in the Preamble of the RTI Act, 2005, we would be willing to provide information that you may need in respect of any specific period of the Hon'ble Prime Minister's visit. We shall await a further communication from you in this regard before taking any further action in the matter.

In case the applicant is not satisfied with the response given by the undersigned, the applicant may file an appeal within 30 days of the receipt of this communication to Shri Sanjay Verma, Chief of Protocol and First Appellate Authority, Room No. 2001, Jawaharlal Nehru Bhawan, Ministry of External Affairs, 23D, Janpath, New Delhi-110011.
