Reference your Application No. MOEAF/R/2016/00075 dated 15/1/2016, received on 18/1/2016, seeking information under Right to Information Act 2005.

- The applicant has sought the following information:
- 3.1 Whether a diplomatic mission in India is exempt from payment of stamp duty on lease/sale deed executed for or on behalf of it?
- 3.2 If the answer to the aforementioned question is yes, kindly specify the act, rule, order, circular, notification, convention etc. exempting such payment of stamp duty by a diplomatic mission.
- 3.3 Does the exemption apply to every state within the territory of India? If no, kindly specify the states to which the exemption is applicable.
- The following is the response of the CPIO:

For (3.1 & 3.2): Diplomatic Missions in India are exempted from payment of stamp duty on lease/sale deed on the basis of Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, 1961 and Vienna Convention on Consular Relation, 1963. As per *Article 23 of VCDR*, 1961 "the sending State and the head of the mission shall be exempt from all national, regional or municipal dues and taxes in respect of the premises of the mission, whether owned or leased, other than such as represent payment for specific services rendered".

Further, exemption from payment of Stamp duty to the diplomatic missions is also based on the principle of reciprocity, i.e. exemption is granted only if Indian Mission in the respective Country is granted the same exemptions as and when required.

For (3.3:): The exemption is also applied to every state within the territory of India. As per Article 32 of VCCR, 1963 "Consular premises and the residence of the career head of consular post of which the sending State or any person acting on its behalf is the owner or lessee shall be exempt from all national, regional or

municipal dues and taxes whatsoever, other than such as represent payment for specific services rendered". The exemption from payment of Stamp duty to the Consular Posts in Indian states are also based on principle of reciprocity.
