- The following is the response of the CPIO:
 - 1. to 4. No such information is available under the custody of the undersigned.
 - 5. In this connection, this is to state that the PM Shri Narendra Modi presents gifts, as per the laid down norms, to his counterparts and other diplomats during his foreign visits. Information sought by you relates to the type/cost of the gifts presented during his foreign visits. It is true that the procurement of gifts is being met from budgetary grants but the revelation of the information sought would have unintended effects on the foreign relations and that any critical analysis/scrutiny and comparison between quantum and value of the gifts would be totally undesirable and would defeat the very purpose of generating goodwill between the nations. Disclosure of this information may prejudicially affect India's relations with the concerned foreign State, exemption is therefore, sought under section 8(1) (a) of the RTI act 2005, wherein no such information as may prejudicially affect India's relations with a foreign State need be disclosed.
