
Please refer to your RTI application dated 18/05/2015 received on 27/05/2015 seeking information under the RTI Act, 2005.

With respect to the Right to Information Act, 2005, I would like to have the following questions answered from the respective departments/offices:

1. Number of Days Mr. Modi spent in Office (in his cabin/cubicle assigned), number of days spent on OD (Official Duty - including the number of days he travelled to the above mentioned countries) and leaves taken, if any till today i.e. 18th May, 2015 - in short his attendance.
2. How many people along with Mr. Modi traveled to the above mentioned places. I want only the number of people and not their names or designations.
3. The amount of money spent by the Government of India and its agencies in relation to all the foreign trips made to various countries as mentioned in the list above. The cost should include the cost incurred (if any) by the respective embassies in the above mentioned countries for stay and travel of the Prime Minister and the entire contingent.
4. Since all the official travels of all government dignitaries are done by the ailing airlines Air India. How much did a - per head - ticket cost from India to all the places as mentioned in the list above. The price should be after deduction all the concessions/discounts given to government of India employees. for example, New Delhi to Washington, 22,000 INR per head.
5. Is there any budget sanctioned for Foreign trips made by the Prime Minister, if yes then how much money is allocated for this head. I would need the amount allocated along with the amount spent on Prime Ministers trip.
