
In this regard, it is conveyed that in case of **Australia**

- PM Shri Narendra Modi paid an official bilateral visit to Australia (16-18 November, 2014) after attending G20 Leaders' Summit in Brisbane on 15 November, 2014. He visited Sydney, Canberra and Melbourne as part of the bilateral visit.
- MoUs/Agreements signed during PM's visit to Australia in November 2014 are put in the public domain under Documents - Bilateral-Multilateral in the MEA website [www.mea.gov.in](http://www.mea.gov.in).
- Current status of the MoUs is as follows:

MoU on Cooperation in the field of Arts and Culture	The Story of Rama-An exhibition of 101 Indian Miniatures from National Museum, New Delhi has been organised under the aegis of this MoU and was on display at the National Gallery of Australia from 22 May to 23 August 2015
Agreement on Social Security	Exchange of documents for finalizing administrative arrangements has taken place.
MoU on Bilateral Cooperation in the field of Tourism	Two road shows were organized in Sydney and Melbourne in March 2015 under aegis of this MoU. Tourism week was also organized in Sydney in the month of October 2015.
MoU for Combating Narcotics Traffic and Developing Police Cooperation	Cooperation is going on from both sides interacting with each other on the need to need basis.
