

**CORRIGENDUM**

i. Bids received for supply of all the three commodities i.e. Tea, Sunflower oil and Sugar as listed in the tender document would only be accepted. Bids offering to supply one or two of the commodities will not be considered;

ii. Under clause 12 of Section 1 of the tender, Documents to be submitted under serial number (xiii) may be read as:

“Document related to valid license for IEC (Import Export Code)”

iii. Point v) under Annexure 1(A) may be read as:  
“IEC Code (Import Export Code)”

iv. Point iv) under Annexure 1(A) may be read as:  
“GST No. / RC details”

v. Point vii) under clause 12(h) of Section I may be read as :  
“GST No.”

vi. Text ‘VAT’ as occurring in Point (b) under clause 2 of Section II may please be deleted

vii. This is for supply of humanitarian assistance to a foreign partner and not a part of the annual procurement plan of MEA, no special concessions such as exemption from payment of EMD, submission of PBG, etc., are envisaged.

viii. Under SECTION III Schedule of Requirement(SoR) of the tender, first two paras of point (ii) may be read as:

" ii) Tea - Quantity: 300 MT (Net)

Quality:

Orthodox Tea (Black tea other than Kangra tea) of TGFOP grade (10%) and should conform to FSSAI regulations [Food Safety and Standards (Food Products Standards and Food Additives) Regulations, 2011].

Indian Orthodox shall be prepared exclusively from fresh buds, young leaves from the plant *Camellia sinensis*. The product shall have characteristic flavour free from any off odour, taint and mustiness. It shall be free from living insects, moulds, dead insects, insect fragments and rodent contamination visible to the naked eye (corrected if

necessary for abnormal vision). The product shall be free from extraneous matter, added coloring matter and harmful substances."

Remaining formulation shall remain the same.

ix. All other terms and conditions remain the same as per the tender document dated 12.10.2017.
