- National Board of Examinations has been notified by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to conduct NEET-PG 2019 on an All-India basis.
- NBE shall be conducting NEET-PG as a Computer Based Test (CBT) on 6th January 2019 in a single session at all the test centres.
