Please refer to your letter No.Z-11025/234/2010-Emig seeking inputs on updated minimum referral wages/salaries for various categories of immigrant workers in Jordan.

- The Mission has been endeavouring to seek required category wise information from the concerned authorities in Jordan but no inputs have been received hitherto.
- 3. According to a document issued by the Jordanian Ministry of Labour in 2006, the) Minimum wage for Jordanian national was JD110 which was reportedly raised to JD190 w.e.f. 2012 for all workers from vocational fields.
- The Mission have been receiving documents for attestation from various recruiting agencies wherein proposed salaries range between JD170 to JD 350 in respect of various categories of workers viz. Factory workers, Crane operators, tailors. printing press workers, welders, moulders, construction labours, jewelry technicians, cooks/waiters, electricians, mechanics etc. In addition to this, the immigrant workers are also being provided with free medical facilities, Social Security Contribution to cover work injuries, free transport/accommodation facilities, to and fro air fares etc. by the employers.
