Dear *Musay Sayeedji*

Kindly refer to your fax message No. SAN/Cons/415/20/2011 dated 11th November, 2012 regarding lifting of the emigration suspension in case of nurses and para-medical staff in Yemen.

2. Emigration Clearance to Yemen was suspended vide letter No. Z-11025/8/2011-Emig. dated 15-03-2011 for one month and extended till further orders vide letter No. Z-11025/08/2011 dated 18-04-2012. The matter has been reviewed. Though the Ministry of External Affairs have recommended lifting of ban, from the report received from the Ministry of External Affairs it seems that there are several provinces which continue to face tension; as such, the situation in Yemen does not appear to be conducive for lifting suspension on emigration clearance for ECR categories.

3. As far as nurses and para-medical staff are concerned, they do not require emigration clearance from the office of the Protector of Emigrants. As attestation of documents by Indian Mission is compulsory for all categories of workers intending to take employment in Yemen, the Mission may exercise their discernment in attesting such documents depending on the local situation.
